JOB TITLE: CERTIFIED ATHLETIC TRAINER

REQUIREMENTS:

A. Education Level: Bachelor's degree

B. Experience Desired: Bachelor's degree

C. Physical Requirements: Hand-eye/mind-eye coordination, hearing, physical dexterity, the ability to bend, stoop, walk, talk, and sit. The ability to travel between locations.

D. Other Requirements: Fundamentals of Coaching or Equivalent (must be completed one time); Sports First Aid or Prevention and Care of Athletic Injuries or equivalent (must be renewed once every two years); Concussion in Sports – What You Need to Know (must be renewed on an annual basis. National Athletic Trainer Association Certification. Must be available before, during, and after practice for medical assistance.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS AND DUTIES:

1. Assists in the application of protective equipment.
2. Administers first aid and refers injured athletes to a physician for diagnosis and treatment.
3. Decides if an athlete can return to practice or competition.
4. Confiscates and secures all of the athlete's equipment in the case of serious injury or head trauma, until the athlete can return to practice or competition.
5. Serves as the liaison between sick or injured players and their physician.
6. Orders and inventories all training room supplies.
7. Maintains all training room equipment in good operating condition.

- 8. Ensures that all necessary safety materials are available for all athletic contests at all levels.
- 9. Attends all varsity football games and all home varsity contests. Works with building athletic director in scheduling coverage for all other athletic contests.
- 10. Coordinates student trainer program.
- 11. Performs other duties as assigned by supervisors.
