- E. Dresses appropriately for coaching duties at practice and game time.
- F. Adheres to policies and procedures established by the Sioux Falls School District.
- G. Administers first aid to an injured player and take appropriate action such as notifying the family doctor, the parent, athletic director, and building principal.
- H. Communicates between officials and coaches in professional manner.
- I. Attends rules meetings and is familiar with the rules of the game.

- J. Attends coaches meeting as deemed necessary by Coordinator of Athletics.
- K. Performs other duties as assigned.
