- Ability to collaborate with speech clinicians, co-teach therapy sessions and demonstrate therapy techniques.
- Ability to think flexibly and to adapt work to the needs of other speech clinicians.
- Demonstrate organizational skills and initiative for working with minimal direct supervision.
- Evidence of ongoing professional learning.
- Knowledge and experience using technology (low and high tech) for communication and ability to assist speech clinicians in gaining these skills.
- Demonstrated ability to facilitate groups and practice facilitative behaviors.
- Ability to support the design and delivery of professional development at both the district and building levels.

PERFORMANCE STANDARDS:

Support of Beginning Speech Clinicians

- Provides intensive coaching to improve the instructional practice of the beginning speech clinician.
- Provides support for identification, assessment and IEP development for the beginning speech therapist.
- Collaborates with the beginning speech clinician to self-assess and identify skills and needs for professional growth.

JOB SPECIFIC PROFESSIONAL RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Provides speech therapy services on a district-wide basis as dictated by student needs when there is a long-term absence of a building speech clinician.
- Participation in identification, assessment and IEP development for students during peak evaluation times.
