<b>CTS-3010</b>	<b>HEALTH CAREERS I</b>
Length/Credit:	Fall Semester, Two hour block 1 credit
Prerequisite:	None, Open to 11-12 grade
Recommended:	Anatomy, Biology, and Physiology, earned a "C" or better
Location:	Offered at the CTE Academy only
Important Information:	This course has been approved by the South Dakota Department of Education to fulfill high school graduation requirements for Career & Technical Education (CTE).
<p>Students will explore a wide variety of health-related careers by learning and demonstrating basic patient care skills, professional qualities and characteristics, teamwork, and critical thinking. Anatomy, physiology, pathophysiology (disease processes), medical terminology, and word building will be learned and applied throughout this course. The student will also have the opportunity to explore different areas of health care by attending field trips and listening to guest speakers who visit the classroom.</p> <p><b>Health Careers I (CTS-3010)</b> Want a career in the exciting medical profession? Develop an awareness of various health-related careers while learning entrylevel skills needed for all jobs in the profession. Guest speakers, demonstrations and field trips to local health care facilities provide real-life learning opportunities.</p>	

<b>CTS-3020</b>	<b>HEALTH CAREERS II</b>
Length/Credit:	Spring Semester, Two hour block 1 credit
Prerequisite:	Health Career I, <b>earned a "C" or better</b> Open to 11-12 grade, must be 16 years old
Location:	Offered at the CTE Academy only
Important Information:	This course has been approved by the South Dakota Department of Education to fulfill high school graduation requirements for Career & Technical Education (CTE). Students are responsible for providing their <b>own</b> transportation to the internship sites. Students completing Health Careers I and II with a minimum grade of a B qualify to take the South Dakota state CNA examination.
<p>Students will explore interests in various health-related careers during a 10-week internship, in the health care setting. The student will be able to apply basic entry-level health care skills learned in Health Careers I to their internship experience and gain insight into health-related careers. Medical terminology will be utilized throughout this course using journaling and case studies. Classroom instruction will also include exploring first aid, CPR certification, medical math, human growth and development, surgical instruments, safety, dental, and pharmacology.</p> <p><b>Health Careers II (CTS-3020)</b> Try a career in the medical field by completing an internship in a health care facility. Apply entry-level skills while on the job. Upon successful completion of both courses, students are eligible to sit for the Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA) Exam.</p>
