



2020 HIGH SCHOOL SUMMER SCHOOL REGISTRATION GUIDELINES: IN-DISTRICT

**Transportation for summer school is NOT provided

• **In-Classroom Courses: Speech or Team Sports: June 1- June 24 15-day Session: Monday through Thursday from 7:30am to 12:30pm**

CLASSROOM COURSEWORK

Summer school content presented during the 15-day summer school session is equivalent to content presented during a full semester of school. Speech & Team Sports class is worth 0.5 credit and students are expected to attend EVERY class. If a student misses more than 2 classes, the student will be dropped from the course with an “F” grade. **Students will not be excused for family vacations, camps or similar activities.** Students who cannot commit to the required days for summer school should not register. Students who enroll in summer school must be able to benefit from instructional activities presented in groups with a ratio of 1 teacher to 20 or more students.

CHROMEBOOKS

Students will not need their school-issued Chromebooks for summer school. Laptops will be available for student use in the classroom.

ONLINE COURSEWORK

Students enrolling in online classes for summer school **must attend a mandatory scheduled orientation at CTE on June 1, 2020**

Mandatory Orientation Times:

Math (Algebra I / Geometry) 8:00-9:00am

Social Studies/ Government/ Psychology/ Health 8:00-9:00am

Math (Algebra II / Pre-Calculus/ Personal Finance) 9:00-10:00am

Science 10:00-11:00am

English/ Literature & Comp 11:00am-12:00pm

A proctored final exam will be on or before July 23, 2020 from 7:30am-12:30pm. Students must also attend proctored unit exams at CTE throughout the summer as they work through the material. Online instructors will be available at scheduled times to administer **on-site unit exams** during regular summer school hours. Students will be allowed to advance through their course ONLY as they complete their unit exams. **Most coursework is completed independently by the student online. Teacher assistance will be available from 7:30am – 12:30pm (Monday- Thursday).** Individual teachers will also schedule appointments for students who need additional help. All work must be completed by 12:30pm on July 23, 2020.

Because online work is intense, **students may only register for one online course at a time** during the 8 week summer session. If all required work is completed in a shorter time frame, the summer school principal may authorize the student to take another online course upon teacher recommendation.

Computer Requirements: To complete online work, students must have access to an Internet connection. School computers are available for student use at CTE Monday through Thursday, 7:30am to 12:30pm. Coursework is not compatible with iPad.

WORK FOR CREDIT

Work for Credit begins June 1, 2020. **Mandatory orientation** is June 1, 2020 from 9:00am- 10:00am. A 0.5 credit will be earned upon completion of 68 verified hours worked and required assignments completed. Additional credit can be earned per supervisor approval. The registration deadline is May 19, 2020. Students are responsible for securing their own employment.

IN-DISTRICT REGISTRATION DETAILS

- Students **currently enrolled** full-time in SFSD 49-5 (Lincoln, Roosevelt, Washington, New Technology, Axtell, Edison, McGovern, Memorial, Patrick Henry & Whittier)
- Tuition is paid per half credit: Reduced pricing available for those qualifying for reduced and free lunch.
 - ✓ In-Classroom, Online & Work for Credits: Registration deadline is **May 19, 2020**
 - ✓ Registration Fees: \$170 SFSD 49-5 enrolled in-district regular rate; \$125 SFSD 49-5 enrolled in-district reduced lunch rate; \$95 SFSD 49-5 enrolled in-district free lunch rate.

Students can register for Speech or Team Sport or Work for Credit in addition to ONE online course.

Students who successfully complete an Online Course & gain the approval of the principal may enroll in an additional Online Course.

NOTE: **There will be NO REFUNDS unless a course is cancelled due to insufficient enrollment.**

HOW TO REGISTER

- **Full Pay Students:** After receiving approval from a school counselor, work with a parent/guardian to register online with a credit or check card. Please visit www.sf.k12.sd.us, hover the mouse over the “Schools” tab on the top of the page, and click on “Summer School- High School”. Parents, click on “Enroll Someone Else” when registering for summer school instead of “Enroll Myself.”
- **Free and Reduced Rate Students:** Students who qualify for free and reduced lunch rates receive a discount on summer school registration. Please make sure “yes” is checked on the Information Disclosure form with the Child Nutrition Office to have eligibility status shared with the Summer School Office. After receiving approval from a school counselor, work with a parent/guardian to register in one of the following ways:

Register online following the instructions above for **Full Pay Students**. Select the payment amount based on your status.

If unable to register online, please contact your counselor for details or you may come to IPC at 201 East 38th Street with payment in full. Cash, check or money order will be accepted.

All Students: Payments and Registrations will be verified daily and will be accepted in the order in which they were received.
